What is a fire rated certification ?

Fire Rated Certification

Fire Rated Certification is a standard set by Certifire, who is an independent third-party certification scheme that assures performance, quality, reliability and traceability of products and systems.

Architects, specifiers, contractors, and building owners can all benefit from fire rated doors since it guarantees that properly installed fire prevention will function as expected. As a result, costly mistakes are avoided, and risk is drastically reduced.



Fire doors are assigned an FD rating associated with length of time they can withstand fire for. For instance an FD30 fire door will offer 30 minutes of protection, while an FD60 fire door will offer 60 minute fire protection.

The FD rating is assigned following stress testing in conditions specified in British Standards 476 part 22:1987.

The most common integrity ratings are:

- ✓ FD30 – 30 minutes
- ✓ FD60 – 60 minutes
- ✓ FD90 – 90 minutes
- ✓ FD120 – 120 minutes

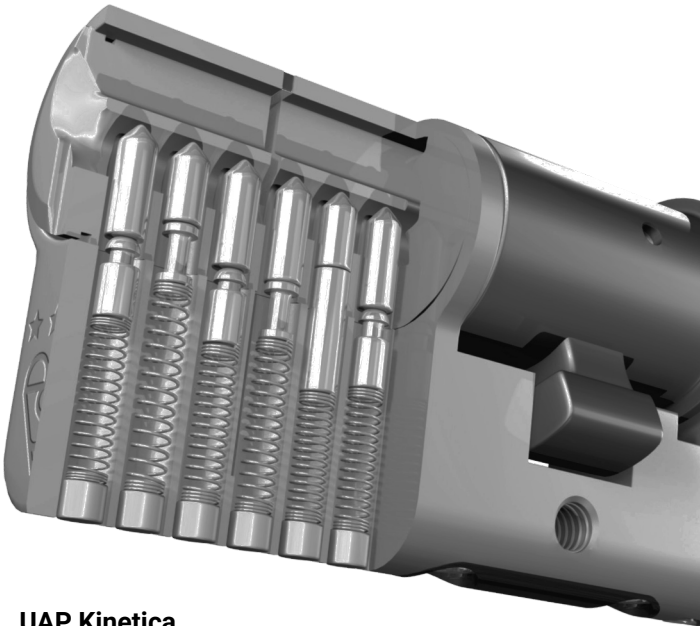
